Download the Millennium Environment Software for Windows

You can download the **milup130.exe**, **milup131.exe**, **milup141.exe**, or **milup142.exe** file here, as indicated below. After downloading the appropriate file, run it to install the Millennium Environment software on a PC running a Millennium application. To do this, follow the instructions below.



You can print these instructions by selecting the **Print** button on your browser's toolbar or by selecting the **File** menu and the **Print** option.

Instructions

Before you begin, make sure that you know the IP address of the library's Innovative machine; you will be asked for this information as part of the installation. Additionally, you need to know what version of software your system is running so you can download the correct version of the client. To find the version, follow these steps in the character-based system, starting at the Main Menu.

M > MANAGEMENT information
I > INFORMATION about the system
F > FILE information

Note the Innovative software version number labeled "Software Release."

Software Release	File
Release 2001	milup130.exe (installs JRE 1.3)
Release 2002 Phase 1	milup130.exe (installs JRE 1.3)
Release 2002 Phase 2	milup131.exe (installs JRE 1.3.1_02)
Release 2002 Phase 3	milup141.exe (installs JRE 1.4.1_02)
Millennium Silver, Release 2005 LE, Release 2005, and Release 2006 LE	milup142.exe (installs JRE 1.4.2_08)



The Millennium installation wizard automatically checks your system for other versions of the JRE. Your system JRE is preserved unless that version was installed by an older Millennium Environment. Prior to Release 2002 Phase 2, older versions of the JRE installed by Millennium are overwritten. On PC's with Release 2002 Phase 3 and later, Millennium applications will no longer use the system JRE. Instead, they will use the JRE that the

Millennium wizard installs in the Millennium directory.

Organizations downloading JRE 1.4.1_02 and 1.4.2_08, and using either Windows 2000 or Windows NT, note the following:

- If you are running Windows 2000, you must have Windows 2000 Service Pack 2 or later.
- If you are running Windows NT, you must have Windows NT Service Pack 6a or later.

Download the appropriate installer file to your system. You *must* follow this procedure for each Windows PC that will run the workstation software, even if the PC will run the software from a network directory.

Millennium Silver, Release 2005 LE, Release 2005, and Release 2006 LE

The milup142.exe file installs JRE 1.4.2_08, which is needed by many non-Western libraries and by many libraries that catalog materials in non-Western languages.

JRE 1.4.2_08 is the preferred version for Millennium Silver, Release 2005 LE, Release 2005, and Release 2006 LE. JRE 1.4.1_02 can be used with Millennium Silver, 2005LE, 2005, and 2006 LE.

1. Download the appropriate file to a temporary directory on your PC (for example, C:\TEMP). This directory can be any temporary directory you choose. When you click the file download link above, your browser should open a **Save As** dialog, allowing you to specify the directory to use for saving the file.



You might not be prompted to choose a directory. If that happens, after the file downloads, copy it from the default download directory into which the browser placed the file to a temporary directory.

2. From the Windows desktop main menu, choose the **Start | Run...** command. Enter the following command in the Open box; use the temporary directory into which you downloaded the software.

```
c:\temp\milup142.exe
```

Choose **OK** to proceed.

3. The setup program begins to load and, if you have not previously installed the environment software, prompts you to enter the Innovative server IP address.
4. The installation will display the following message:

```
Copying Java Runtime Environment. This may take several minutes. Please wait...
```

When the installation finishes, **milup142.exe** installation adds an

"Innovative Millennium" icon on your desktop.



To verify that the Innovative Millennium icon points to the correct JRE:

- a. Right-click the icon.
- b. Choose **Properties | Shortcut**.
- c. In the "Target:" box, look for the pointer to the JRE directory. It should be:

```
C:\Millennium\iirunner.exe
```

The information that Millennium needs to connect to the Millennium server is stored in a separate file in the C:\Millennium directory called **iirunner.lax**. **Do not edit this file.**

The Millennium Environment software installation is complete. You may need to restart Windows in order for it to reload any system files that were updated during the setup.



The Millennium applications rely on the fixed location of the Millennium Environment. After you install the Millennium Environment, you cannot move these programs and files or rename the Millennium directory.

Release 2002 Phase 3

1. Download the appropriate file to a temporary directory on your PC (for example, C:\TEMP). This directory can be any temporary directory you choose. When you click the file download link above, your browser should open a **Save As** dialog, allowing you to specify the directory to use for saving the file.



You might not be prompted to choose a directory. If that happens, after the file downloads, copy it from the default download directory into which the browser placed the file to a temporary directory.

```
c:\temp\milup141.exe
```

Release 2002 Phase 2 and Earlier

1. Download the appropriate file to a temporary directory on your PC (for example, C:\TEMP). This directory can be any temporary directory you choose. You might not be prompted to choose a directory. If that happens, after the file downloads, copy it from the default download directory into which the browser placed the file to a temporary directory.

2. From the Windows desktop main menu, choose the **Start | Run...** command. Enter the following command in the Open box; use the directory into which you downloaded the software.

`c:\temp\milup130.exe`

or

`c:\temp\milup131.exe`



If you execute **milup130.exe** or **milup131.exe** on a PC running the previous Millennium Environment software, the prior version will be *overwritten* if that JRE was installed by Millennium Environment software.

Choose **OK** to proceed.

3. The setup program begins to load and, if you have not previously installed the environment software, prompts you to enter the Innovative server IP address.
4. The installation will display the following message:

Copying Java Runtime Environment. This may take several minutes. Please wait...

When the installation finishes, it adds a "Millennium" icon on your desktop.



To verify that the Millennium icon points to the correct JRE:

1. Right-click the icon.
2. Choose **Properties | Shortcut**.
3. In the "Target:" box, look for the pointer to the JRE directory. Depending on your version of the JRE, it should resemble:

```
C:\Program Files\JavaSoft\Jre\1.3.1_02  
\bin\java.exe
```

If the `C:\Program Files\JavaSoft\Jre\` entry does not point to the correct JRE, manually correct it. For example, if you downloaded **milup131.exe**, your shortcut should point to:

```
C:\Program Files\JavaSoft\Jre\1.3.1_02  
\bin\java.exe
```

The Millennium Environment software installation is complete. You may need to restart Windows to reload any system files that were updated during the setup.
